Crack Coalition Considered

PLANTATION -- A coordinated effort involving all 28 cities in Broward County is needed to overcome the crack cocaine epidemic, according to county Crime Commission Chairman Frank R. Pinter.

At Pinter's suggestion, the board of directors for the Broward League of Cities agreed in principle on Thursday to create an anti-cocaine coalition.

The board will explore how to create the coalition and establish goals for it. Among the suggestions discussed:

- Warning of the danger of crack addiction through posters and billboards.
- Making drug rehabilitation for current addicts a higher priority.
