ANTI-BIO TERRORISM PROGRAM COMPLETED

This program which was developed by Dr. Joshua Perper Md is a 45 minute slide show depicting bio-terrorism history and its effects on society in general.

Bill Zibell, crime commission director took on the project of adding a voice narration to the slide show which is a Microsoft Power Point Program..

The show is designed for the general public as an information program.

The Crime Commission issued a CD-Rom to each Police Department and to the Sheriffs districts with the thought that the program could be used by them in their public relations units.

Also given to each agency was a bio- terrorism symptom recognition and preparedness chart This chart was created by the National Memorial Institute for the Prevention of Terrorism.
