



Crime Commission Picks Prosecutor of the Year

BROWARD COUNTY - The Broward County Crime Commission has honored Assistant State Attorney Mike Flynn as Broward's Prosecutor of the Year.

Flynn, a 19-year veteran of the State Attorney's Office, is recovering in a Fort Lauderdale hospital from a stroke he suffered in December.

State Attorney Mike Satz presented the award to Flynn's son, Jamieson, and daughters Jillian and Tamara on Thursday.

"We want you to understand what a respected lawyer and a fine gentleman we think your father is," Satz told them.

Flynn is a former Organized Crime prosecutor now assigned to the Career Criminal Unit.
